



Water Policy

Policy Statement

Witmans Industries is committed proactively to initiate preservation of most important natural resource by ensuring strict monitoring to control the consumption of water at it's manufacturing sites and administrative offices.

Purpose

To address issues of water sustainability Witmans industries established a "Water Policy" to manage the strategies, systems, and to identify practices and processes to ensure compliance will all the legal requirements, minimize the water wastage and; monitor and control water usage during processes and discharges, if any.

Principles and Applicability

By adopting the best practices, Witmans Industries will carry out its core business activities, on the 3 principles of Reduce, Reuse and Recycle for water conservation and management at all its manufacturing locations.

Objectives

- a. Controlling consumption of water by initiating strict monitoring to enable setting up overall consumption targets for water consumption to the respective sites.
- b. Identify & establish best practices in the industry for reduce, reuse & recycle water as a part of 'water conservation and management' plan.

Policy

Ensure that all manufacturing locations are compliant with water-related regulations, like:

- Compliance beyond Environmental norms on Specific Water Consumption,
- Discharges, if any, shall be as per stipulated norms and efforts are to be made to achieve beyond norms.
- Identify water-related risks and its mitigation strategies.
- To develop water management systems to update actual water balance accordingly, based on the consumption monitoring outcome, to initiate timely and appropriate actions.

Responsibility

Responsibility of implementation of this policy is primarily that of the respective plant heads of the manufacturing locations, with involvement and the guidance of corporate office bearers.

Witmans Industries commits to support and implement this Water Policy. This policy shall be reviewed at opportune time, but not later than once in three years.
